Citizenship in the Nation Cape Girardeau MO Tuesday, July 7, 2020

Location: Rush H. Limbaugh, Sr., U.S. Courthouse (NOTE: Unlike in previous years, this program will be held entirely at a single location)

Times: Arrive at 9:00 a.m. for check-in. Program begins at 9:30 a.m. Dismissal will be at 4:00 p.m.



Learn what it means to be a citizen of the United States by participating in a full day of sessions held at the Rush H. Limbaugh, Sr., U.S. Courthouse. A variety of presenters will cover the Badge requirements, including a federal judge. The workshop is free, but reservations are required, and space is limited.

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY AS REGISTRATION HAS CHANGED FROM PREVIOUS YEARS:

- Minimum age requirement: Scouts MUST have reached 13th birthday by July 7.
- This program is only open to Scouts from any District.
- Registrations will be taken on a first come, first served basis, **beginning at 7:00 A.M. on Monday, March 30**. Once the program is full, additional names will be added to a waiting list.
- To register, email EducationTeam@ca8.uscourts.gov on Monday, March 30. Emails will be checked in the order they are received, beginning at 7:00 a.m. Phone registrations will not be taken.
 - Subject line of the email: July 7 Citizenship in the Nation CAPE
 - You may register multiple Scouts with one email, but you MUST have complete information for each Scout. Spots will not be held for any Scouts with missing information.
 - Include the following information for EACH Scout:
 - Full Name
 - Scout District AND Troop #
 - Age Scout will be on July 7
 - Allergies/special needs/other health concerns
 - Name of parent attending (optional)
 - Name and cell # of an emergency contact who is NOT attending the program
 - Email address and phone number for each Scout/family
- NOTE: Logistics packet and required pre-requisite assignments are posted here https://judiciallearningcenter.org/citizenship-in-the-nation-for-scouts/
 - Each family is responsible for accessing the packet and going over the logistics on their own.
 - Each Scout must print out the pre-requisites, or complete on separate paper USING THE FORMAT IN THE PACKET. Do not use other packets you might find on other websites.

To Bring: Scouts should bring a copy of the Merit Badge Pamphlet, a pencil, and a signed Merit Badge Card. Scouts will need to bring completed pre-requisite activities, a lunch, a water bottle, and a morning snack.
