INFORMATION & PROCEDURES

Boy Scouts of America has changed the guidelines for awarding Eagle Palms. There are 3 different rules for issuing Palms.

1. The first change was made on August 1, 2017. This change allowed Scouts who successfully completed the Eagle Scout board of review on or after August 1, 2017 to receive an Eagle Palm for each additional five merit badges earned before the Eagle Scout board of review without delay.
2. The second change was made October 2017. This change allowed Scouts who successfully completed their Eagle board of review and who had not passed their 18th birthday before August 1, 2017 to receive Palms. The merit badges must have been earned before the date of the Eagle Scout board of review. One Palm may be issued for each five merit badges earned.
3. Palms may be issued for merit badges earned after the Eagle Scout board of review along with completion of 4 other requirements.
