Richard McClure

Rich McClure is the former President and CEO of UniGroup, the parent company of United Van Lines, Mayflower Transit, UniGroup Relocation, and UniGroup Logistics. He currently serves as Principal of his consulting firm, Spero Advisers, LLC, which provides strategic planning and governance advisory services to founder- and visionary-led organizations.

Rich has a life-long connection to the Boy Scouts. An Eagle Scout, he served as a past lodge Chief of the Order of the Arrow, Camp Staff Assistant Director and Philmont Trek leader. He served as President of the Greater St. Louis Area Council of the Boy Scouts of America and is a recipient of the Silver Beaver Award.

He earned his bachelor's degree in management from Missouri State University (summa cum laude) and his master's degree in public administration from The Maxwell School of Syracuse University. Early in his career, he held public policy positions as chief of staff for then-Missouri Governor and former U.S. Attorney General John Ashcroft; and as deputy chief of staff to Governor Jim Thompson of Illinois; also serving in the cabinet as director of Illinois' Department of Central Management Services.

After 20 years in corporate leadership, Rich left UniGroup 2014 to pursue "Life Phase Three" with his wife Sharon, where they focus on family, civic and faith-based priorities. He co-chaired the Ferguson Commission appointed by the Governor of Missouri in November, 2014 to study and recommend actions to address the underlying causes of the social unrest in the St. Louis region. The Commission issued their report "Forward though Ferguson" in late 2015.

In 2016, Rich was a recipient of the St. Louis Award and in 2017, was awarded an honorary doctorate from St. Louis University. He currently chairs the Board of Trustees of St. Louis Children's Hospital and recently served as chair of the Board of the United Way of Greater St. Louis. Rich currently serves as lead director on the board of World Wide Technology and as a director of Central Banccompany. He is on the advisory boards of several other privately held founder-led companies.

Governors of Missouri and Illinois, education policy director for the Illinois House staff, Deputy Director of the Illinois Community College Trustees Association, Director of Governmental Relations for the Southern Illinois University system and Director of Public Affairs for the Missouri Department of Mental Health. She 'retired' from public service to take care of her young family and her brother, who died of ALS.

Together, Sharon and Rich have co-chaired the large donor campaign of the St. Louis United Way and together serve on the Board of Governors of Opportunity International, the largest faith-based microfinance organization that operates in 22 developing countries. They are active members of Greentree Community Church and served together on the St. Louis area Young Life Committee for 10 years. In 2011, they were the first husband and wife on the CBS show, Undercover Boss, featuring United Van Lines.

Sharon and Rich have been married 42 years and have two married children, Ryan McClure and Lindsay McClure-Hartman. They have four grandchildren. Her favorite current title is: "Gammy".
